	1. A head trauma	any damage to the scalp , skull or brain caused by injury .	Traumatisme cerebral
	2. A pharmacist	a person who is professionally qualified to prepare and dispense medicinal drugs .	Un pharmacien
	3. A gynecologist	a doctor skilled in the treatment of women's diseases, especially those of the reproductive organs	Un gynécologue
	4. Depression	a mental illness in which a person is very unhappy and anxious (= worried and nervous) for long periods and cannot have a normal life during these periods:	La dépression
	5. A pediatrician	a doctor with special training in medical care for children	Un pédiatre
	6. a prescription	a piece of paper on which a doctor writes the details of the medicine or drugs that someone needs	Une ordonnance
	7. Cancer	a serious disease in which growths of cells , also called cancers, form in the body and kill normal body cells. The disease often causes death.	Le cancer
	8. Light-headed	not completely in control of your thoughts or movements; slightly faint .	étourdi
	9. A GP [general practitioner]	a doctor who is trained in general medicine and who works in the local community, not in a hospital.	Un médecin généraliste
	10. A nurse	a person whose job is to take care of sick or injured people , usually in a hospital.	Une infirmière
