## How much ...? | How many ...?

1- How much / how many = « combien (de) ». Comment savoir lequel employer?

How much + nom singulier How many + nom pluriel **'How much money** do you have ?' 'How many siblings do you have?' Tu as combien d'argent sur toi? Tu as combien de frères et sœurs?

### 2- Parfois le nom peut être sous-entendu :

- a. 'How much is the book?' ( = how much money is the book?)
- b. 'I would like some pears please.' 'Sure, how many?' (= 'How many pears would you like?')

# How often ...? | How many times ...?

1- 'How often ... ?' = « tous les combien ? ». Il interroge sur la fréquence.

'How often do you go to the cinema?' – 'Once a week'. « Tu vas au cinéma tous les combien ? » - « Une fois par semaine. »

#### Réponses possibles :

- Every day: tous les jours
- Every two days: tous les deux jours
- Every other weekend : un week-end sur deux
- Once a week: une fois par semaine
- Twice a month: deux fois par mois.
- Five times a year : cinq fois par an
- 2- How many times ...? = 'combien de fois ...?'

How many times did you do the laundry last week? Combien de fois as-tu fait la lessive cette semaine?
