

LISTENING TEST – Practice 1 (Toeic)

Listening test in the listening test you will be asked to demonstrate how well you understand spoken English the entire listening test will last approximately 45 minutes there are four parts and directions are given for each part you must mark your answers on the separate answer sheet do not write your answers in your test book

Part one - directions :

For each question in this part you will hear four statements about a picture in your test book. When you hear the statements, you must select the one statement that best describes what you see in the picture, then find the number of the question on your answer sheet and mark your answer the statements will not be printed in your test book and will be spoken only one time. Look at the **example** item below. Now listen to the four statements

- A. they're moving some furniture
- B. they're entering a meeting room
- C. they're sitting at a table
- D. they're cleaning the carpet

Statement C “they're sitting at a table” is the best description of the picture. So you should select answer C and mark it on your answer sheet. Now part one will begin

- A. one of the women is writing on a notepad

➤ *Number five look at the picture marked number five in your test book*

- A. cars are parked in a garage
- B. plants are arranged on tables
- C. there are umbrellas blocking a road

➤ *Number six look at the picture marked number six in your test book*

- A. some travellers are seated in a waiting area**
